

Integrate Your WordPress Site with the CreatePay WooCommerce Plugin

Below is a step-by-step guide to integrate your existing WordPress + WooCommerce site with the Open Payment Network WooCommerce plugin.


1) Check Prerequisites (2 minutes)

- WordPress / WooCommerce versions: Ensure compatibility with WordPress up to 6.x and WooCommerce 6.x.
- PHP extension: Ensure BCMath is enabled on your hosting server.

Tip: In WordPress, go to WooCommerce → Status to see your system report.

2) Download the Plugin ZIP (1 minute)

Visit the repository at https://github.com/Open-Payment-Network/WooCommerce → Code → Download ZIP.



3) Install the Plugin

via WordPress admin:


- 1. In WP admin, go to Plugins \rightarrow Add New \rightarrow Upload Plugin.
- Choose File (select the ZIP you downloaded) → Install Now → Activate.





4) Enable the Gateway in WooCommerce (2 minutes)

- 1. Go to WooCommerce → Settings → Payments (or Checkout).
- 2. Find Cardstream in the list of methods, click Manage/Set up, toggle Enable, then Save changes.



5) Configure Credentials (5–10 minutes)

In the gateway settings screen, fill in the following:

- Title Cardstream
- Type of Integration Direct or Hosted as per your requirements
- Description Pay Securely via Credit/Debit Card CreatePay
- Merchant ID as per your welcome email
- Merchant country code 826
- Signature Key
 – as per your welcome email.
- Gateway URL (Hosted) https://payments.createpay.com/paymentform/
- Gateway URL (Direct) https://payments.createpay.com/direct
- Responsive Form Yes
- Customer Wallets Yes

6) (Optional) Pre-set Defaults via config.php

You can pre-fill defaults in the config.php file inside the plugin directory. This is optional — UI configuration is sufficient.



7) Test the Checkout (5 minutes)

- 1. Add a low-priced test product to your cart.
- 2. Proceed to Checkout and select your named payment option.
- 3. Complete a test transaction using your credentials.
- 4. Confirm the WooCommerce order status updates to Processing/Completed.
- 5. Confirm the payment has been completed in your CreatePay Dashboard https://dashboard.createpay.com/ using your login credentials supplied in your welcome email.

*If using a test site, test cards can be used, located https://guides.gitbook.io/integrationguide/references/feature-references/integration-testing, if using a live site you must use live card details for any test.

8) Go Live

Perform a small real transaction to confirm settlement.

9) Quick Troubleshooting Checklist

- Plugin active? Check Plugins → Installed.
- WooCommerce enabled and updated? Check WooCommerce → Status.
- PHP-BCMath installed? Confirm with your host.
- Order status not updating? Check firewalls, security plugins, and gateway callbacks.
- Payment method not showing? Ensure it's enabled under WooCommerce \rightarrow Settings \rightarrow Payments.
